Though we've rarely been asked about this, we would like to inform you about an interesting possibility:

The conversion of existing CYPRES 2 civilian units from one model to another.

For example, if a drop zone has a changed demand, CYPRES 2 units can be switched to other models.

Student	-	Tandem
Tandem	-	Expert
Expert	-	Student

We are sticking with principles and philosophies, including "Safety First", that have been proven by our 14-year experience with skydivers around the world. Thus the model will not be able to be switched in the field.

Why? Both technical and safety.

There will continue to be no risk of accidentally setting the unit in an inappropriate mode, which could result in a too high or too low activation.

Conversions will be made by the same people at Airtec that built the unit, including new settings, a new color corresponding push button, a new label, and a complete functional test.

Once converted to the new model, users can continue to be confident that the unit will operate as expected, with no compromises in safety or reliability. No Surprises!

The conversion procedure will be performed at no charge, as a courtesy to CYPRES 2 owners. As usual, Western Hemisphere owners may send units to SSK in the U.S.



More news:

After 2 years with CYPRES 2, we have successfully integrated the Tandem unit into the Expert/Student production process.

Therefore, we can now offer the **Tandem CYPRES 2** for the **same price** as the Expert and Student CYPRES 2 models. This price reduction will be effective June 1, 2005.

In short:

All civilian units (Expert, Tandem, Student) will cost the same.

The only price difference is between a 1-pin and a 2-pin CYPRES unit.
